Borrowing Privileges

Borrowing privileges are available free to all residents and non-residents of Craftsbury regardless of race, color, national origin, sex, sexual orientation, religion, age, disability, political beliefs, or marital or family status. The following conditions apply:

- All borrowers shall register at the Library, giving contact information.
- Materials may be borrowed for two weeks, and are subject to renewal, if the item is not on reserve for another patron. Only two renewals are allowed unless specifically approved by the Library Director. Patrons who do not return overdue materials or who lose materials may, at the discretion of the Library Director, lose borrowing privileges until materials are returned or restitution made.
- Patrons who damage materials may, at the discretion of the Library Director, lose borrowing privileges until the damage is paid for or the replacement cost of the material is met.

Interlibrary Loan

Interlibrary Loan is to be encouraged for expansion of the scope of materials available to patrons. Patrons may request specific titles or collections in subject areas. The Librarians will make known to users the services of Interlibrary Loan, the availability of borrowing privileges through school and public libraries in the area, and services through the ABLE (Audio, Braille, Large Print, Ebooks) Library of the Department of Libraries and the Library of Congress.
